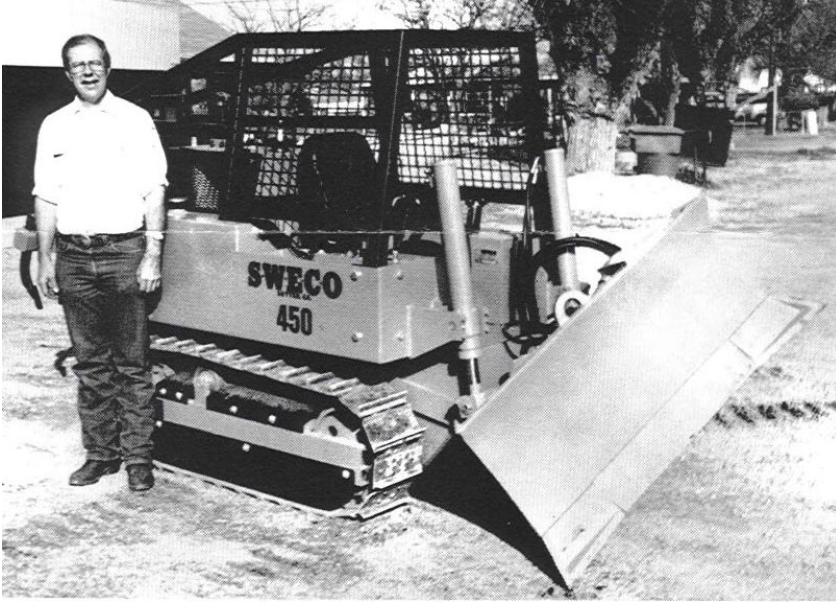


STOLEN EQUIPMENT
