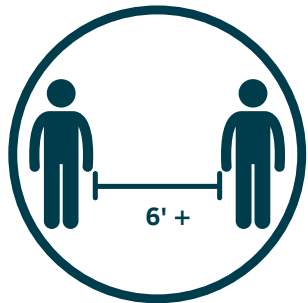


As most professional trail crews are small (typically one to six workers), working outside of normal exposure to the public, trailbuilding is an inherently “socially isolated” industry. PTBA believes that utilizing best practices in maintaining a hygienic and safe work site can minimize the potential of exposure to COVID-19 for crew members and members of the general public.



- Maintain physical (social) distancing - 6' OR MORE
- Use proper respiratory etiquette and follow the most updated guidelines for mask-wearing in your area



- Utilize frequent and thorough hand washing
- Disinfect any equipment that is shared prior to use AND at the end of each work day



- Maintain a self-contained and self-sufficient work site as is feasible
- If people outside the work crew are in proximity, mandate that those individuals maintain at least 6 feet of distance
- Screen crew daily for coronavirus symptoms (fever, cough, difficulty breathing)
